



TERMS AND CONDITIONS – 'MAJOR PRIZE' PROMOTION (QLD Residents only)

1. Entry into the International Women's Day Fun Run (IWDFR) '**MAJOR PRIZE**' ("**Promotion**") is deemed to be an acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. Information on how to enter the Promotion and prizes associated with the Promotion form part of these Conditions of Entry.
 2. Entries for the Promotion commence at 08:00hrs AEST Thursday 20 November 2025 and close at 23:59hrs AEST Sunday 8 March 2026 ("**Promotion Period**").
 3. Entry is open ONLY to IWDFR participants who are both:
 - 3.1. Residents of Queensland, Australia and are over the age of 18 years on Sunday 8 March 2026 ("**Entrants**").
 4. Directors, officers, management, employees and other staff (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees and other staff) of Mater Foundation and their related bodies corporate and agents are ineligible to enter.
 5. The Promoter reserves the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter have reason to believe breached any of these conditions or engaged in any unlawful or otherwise improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
 6. To enter, Entrants must raise \$50.00 or more during the promotion period with funds raised displayed on their individual IWDFR 2025 fundraising page at <https://womensdayfunrun.com.au/>.
 - 6.1. The final number of entries per Entrant will be calculated in \$50 increments in accordance with the total fundraising amount visible on each entrant's fundraising page as at the end of the Promotion Period. Entries will be applied based on the fundraising amount achieved at 23:59hrs AEST Sunday 8 March 2026, as set out below:

For example:
\$50 raised = 1 entry.
\$75 raised = 1 entry.
\$200 raised = 4 total entries.
\$500 raised = 10 total entries.
\$1,500 raised = 30 total entries.
\$2,000 raised = 40 total maximum entries
 - 6.2. Each valid entry received during the Promotion Period will be placed in the related Major Prize Draw.
 - 6.3. Multiple entries are permitted, with the maximum number of entries being forty (40). Refer Clause 6.1 for more information.
 7. There are a total of 1 x major prize winners ("**Major Prize Winner**").
 8. The total prize pool is valued at \$9,900 (RRP).
 9. The Major Prize Winner will receive:

 12. The Major Prize Winners will be contacted by email with details of how to claim their prize.
 13. Entries must be received by the Promoters within the Promotion Period. Entries are deemed to be received upon a verified donation being received to a participant's fundraising page at www.womensdayfunrun.com.au during the promotion period (Virtual or Physical event).
14. **Prizes**

- 14.1. The Major Prize Winners will be given the option of collecting the prize items from the Mater Foundation office (Newstead) or collecting this from the Natasha Schweitzer showroom (Brisbane) If the above options aren't possible for any Major Prize Winner, Mater Foundation will organise transfer of the prize items including all freight costs associated.
- 14.2. Tennis bracelet – Will be ordered by Mater Foundation from Natasha Schweitzer once the metal has been selected by the winner. The winner can choose gold or white gold metal finish for this item. If for any reason beyond the Promoter's control, the Tennis bracelet design is not possible following the draw or re-draw, then a similarly styled and equal value jewellery item will be provided to the Winner (refer Clause 16.2).
- 14.3. The value of the prize pool is accurate at the date of commencement of the Promotion Period. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize after that date.
- 14.4. The Prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
- 14.5. Should the Major Prize winner be required to travel to Brisbane to redeem the prize, the winner will be responsible for any costs associated with this travel.

- 14.7. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen prizes once handover has been completed.

Where Mater Foundation is unable to verify or contact a winner or any prize remains unclaimed after all reasonable attempts have been made to locate or otherwise contact the winner, the prize/s will be held for at least 3 months, after which time the Promoter will hold an unclaimed prize draw to select an alternative winner. The unclaimed prize draw will be held at 10:00 AEST, Wednesday 25 June 2026 at 14 Stratton Street, Newstead, 4006 or remotely by Microsoft Teams. The alternative winner will be notified by phone and email within 5 days of the unclaimed prize draw about the amount of the prize and of the time and place at which it may be collected.

15. Entry to Promotion

- 15.1. The Promoter reserves the right to validate and check the authenticity of entries and to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process.
- 15.2. The Promoter and its associated agencies or companies accept no responsibility for lost, late, stolen, damaged or misdirected entries.
- 15.3. The Promoter has no control over internet or mobile telecommunications, network lines, bugs, viruses or server problems, and accepts no responsibility for any problems associated with them, for whatever reason.
- 15.4. Any entry that is lodged by automatic, repetitive, robotic, programmed or similar methods will be deemed void as determined in the absolute discretion of the Promoter.
- 15.5. All entries become the property of the Promoter.

16. No Liability

- 16.1. If any act or omission, event or circumstance occurs which is beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter and which prevents the Promoter from complying with these Conditions of Entry, the Promoter will not be liable for any failure to perform or any delay in performing its obligations.
- 16.2. The Promoter reserves the right, subject to any applicable law, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion.
- 16.3. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered, including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss, or for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving, taking or using any Prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 16.4. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liability incurred as a result of participating in this Promotion. Any tax liability arising as a result of accepting any Prize is the responsibility of the Winner.

17. Consent
