



Terms and Conditions – International Women’s Day Fun Run 2026

Raise \$48 in 48 hours promotion (Game of Skill)

1. Entry into the International Women's Day Fun Run 2026 (IWDFR) **Raise \$48 in 48 hours** (“Promotion”) is deemed to be an acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. Information on how to enter the Promotion and prizes associated with the Promotion form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. The Promotion is a **Game of Skill**, refer to Section 7 to 11.
3. Entries for the Promotion commence at 14:00 hrs AEST Wednesday 4 February 2026 and close at 14:00hrs AEST Friday 6 February 2026 (“Promotion Period”).
4. Entry is open to all IWDFR participants (“Entrants”) who are residents of Australia and over the age of 18 years on Wednesday 4 February 2026.
5. Directors, officers, management, employees and other staff (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees and other staff) of Mater Foundation and their related bodies corporate and agents are ineligible to enter.
6. The Promoter reserves the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter have reason to believe breached any of these conditions or engaged in any unlawful or otherwise improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition.  - 14.2. **‘Your Way’ IWDFR** (excluding Brisbane City Event) – each 5K Your Way participant winner will have the Prize posted to them, to be dispatched by the Promotor via Australia Post regular mail service in the week commencing Monday 23 February 2025.
 - 14.3. **Townsville IWDFR** – each IWDFR Townsville participant winner is to collect the Prize at the Merchandise tent at the IWDFR Townsville Finishers’ Village by 9:30am AEST, Sunday 8 March 2026.
 - 14.4. **Springfield IWDFR** - each IWDFR Springfield participant winner is to collect the Prize at the Merchandise tent at the IWDFR Springfield Finishers’ Village by 9:30am AEST, Sunday 8 March 2026.

15. Entries must be received by the Promoters within the Promotion Period. Entries are deemed to be received upon a verified donation being received to a participants individual fundraising page at www.womensdayfunrun.com.au during the promotion period.

16. Prizes

- 16.1. The value of the prize pool is accurate at the date of commencement of the Promotion Period. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize after that date.
- 16.2. The Prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
- 16.3. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into, including in the event of a dispute.
- 16.4. **(Brisbane City IWDFR, Townsville IWDFR & Springfield IWDFR)** If for any reason the prize is not claimed at the collection point by 9:30 AEST on Sunday 9 March 2025, by respective IWDFR Brisbane City, Townsville and Springfield event Prize Winners, the prize will be forfeited.

17. Entry to Promotion

- 18.1. If any act or omission, event or circumstance occurs which is beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter and which prevents the Promoter from complying with these Conditions of Entry, the Promoter will not be liable for any failure to perform or any delay in performing its obligations.
- 18.2. The Promoter reserves the right, subject to any applicable law, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion.
- 18.3. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered, including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss, or for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving, taking or using any Prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 18.4. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liability incurred as a result of participating in this Promotion. Any tax liability arising as a result of accepting any Prize is the responsibility of the Winner.
